THE COMBINATION OF WARDS FOR SENATE DISTRICT 33 SPECIAL ELECTION

WHEREAS, Section 5.15(6)(b) of the Wisconsin Statutes provides that a municipality having a population of less than 35,000, may combine 2 or more wards for voting purposes to facilitate using a common polling place, and

WHEREAS, the Town of Waukesha has a population of less than 35,000 and has been divided into a combination of 12 wards, and

WHEREAS, the Governor has called a special election for Senate District 33 for July 21, 2015 with the primary election being held on June 23, 2015.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Board that the Wards in the Town of Waukesha shall be combined as follows:

SENATE DISTRICT 33RD SPECIAL PRIMARY AND GENERAL ELECTIONS
WARDS 1 -6 & 8

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all wards will vote at the Town of Waukesha Municipal Complex; in the Fire Station.
